CANNOT BE RECYCLED IN OUR PROGRAM

- Flooring containing asbestos
- Floors from buildings constructed prior to 1990
- Burnt tiles
- Wet, moldy or weathered flooring
- Returned recycling containers with trash or debris
- Material removed from wood subfloors
- Wood and laminate flooring

RECYCLING YOUR OLD FLOORING IS SIMPLE

THE PROCESS

1 register Register your floor recycling project with the Armstrong Flooring On&On™ Floor Recycling Center— at 1 888 276 7876 (option 3)

Submit the required documentation for approval of your project:

- Completed questionnaire describing project (original construction date of the building, products being removed, etc.)

- An asbestos survey

2 confirm

Once approved:

- A signed Recycling Agreement

- A completed Recycling Logistics Form

Be sure your project is approved before you begin removal of the floors for recycling.

3 remove

- Approximately 2 to 4 weeks before demolition, specially labeled recycling containers will ship to your site (keep dry and free of debris)

- Remove furniture, partitions, gondolas and shelving. Sweep up and dispose of debris (not in recycling containers)

- Remove old floor with a floor scraper and shovel into the recycle bins (do not use excessive heat to remove)

4 call us

Attach provided shipping labels to the return freight, cover the top of the recycling containers with stretch wrap and call 1 877 276 7876 (select option 3) to arrange for pickup

Check with your local Armstrong Flooring representative or call the Armstrong Flooring On&On™ Floor Recycling Center at 1 888 276 7876 (option 3) to approve material and for assistance to facilitate recycling. We are continually updating the types of flooring we can recycle and methods in which we can receive them.

Except as otherwise stated, the program is available free of charge in the contiguous United States for jobs with the purchase of new Armstrong® material. There are no job size limitations, however, smaller Less Than Truckload (LTL) jobs may incur a freight charge.
